**Why is church history important for us to know?**

**Why do you think Jesus spent 40 days with His disciples after His resurrection, before His ascension?**

**Why was proving that He was alive so important?**

- How can we be sure Jesus is alive?
- 1 Corinthians 15:19...how do you live so that this verse is true for you?
